## **HAROLD WORKMAN GIFT TO THE FOUNDATION**

Harold Workman was a significant person of intelligence and compassion in West Michigan. From helping bring 7,200 people from the south to work in Muskegon during World War II to working on labor issues and serving on the boards of directors of the YMCA, Hope College and Muskegon General Hospital, his influence was felt widely.

Mr. Workman died last year at the age of 94. His daughter, Marietta Driscoll and son, Harold J. Workman, Jr., forwarded a gift of \$15,000 to the foundation, which Mr. Workman had designated for the foundation through an insurance policy.

This remarkable gift will help the foundation address health needs in West Michigan and will support students and medical residents as they pursue their education and work toward becoming osteopathic physicians.
