

GRANTS AWARDED IN 2008

Muskegon Community Health Project

\$12,759 to support the Muskegon Coalition for Appropriate Antibiotic Therapy (MCAAT) 2008/09 Public Awareness Campaign

Mercy Health Partners

\$4,000 to provide two CME lectures by Martha Twaddle, MD, *Hospice & Palliative Medicine —Where Have We Been and Where Are We Going?*

White Lake Community Library

\$2,000 to expand and update the Library's health and fitness materials, to be split between juvenile/teen services and adult non-fiction services

Continuing Grants (approved in 2007; multiple payments):

Mercy Health Partners

\$50,000 first installment of a \$250,000 grant to be paid over five years to support the Johnson Family Center for Cancer Care

REAL Science Program (MAISD)

Second installment of \$5,000 (\$15,000 over three years) towards the purchase of an incubator, an autoclave, and microscopes.
